Thanks to community donations from families and a grant from the PTSA, we have been able to add **225** books to the library collection! Each donated book receives a commemorative book plate to honor the donor.



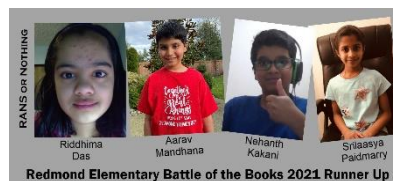

Congratulations ***Fantastic Four*** for winning the Redmond Elementary Battle of the Books 2021 competition!



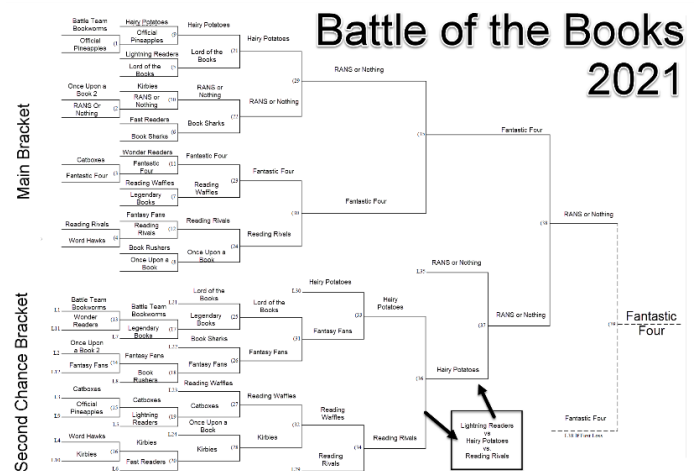
Our second place winning team was ***RANS or Nothing!***



Battle of the Books is an extracurricular activity for 4th & 5th grade students.

Students commit to

reading 12 books between September and February of each school year and compete each spring in game show style competitions. Battles are structured using a double elimination bracket system similar to March Madness Basketball.



Each year 3rd and 4th grade students will receive a reading list for the following year in June to get a head start.
